Background Information

Sexual Exploitation of children and young people often has a long-lasting and harmful impact on their lives. Professionals, parents and carers can sometimes find it difficult to identify, and support children and young people at risk. It is vital that those working with children and young people are aware of this specific form of abuse and can take a pro-active and co-ordinated approach to prevent further harm.
