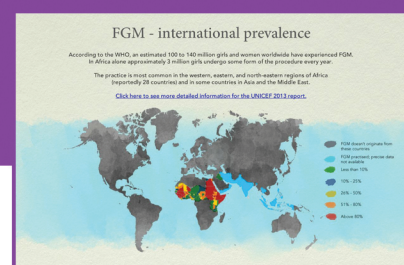
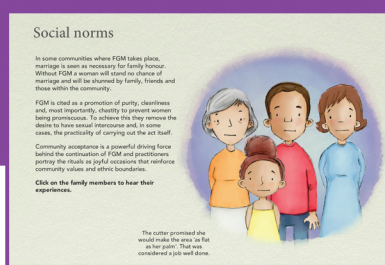
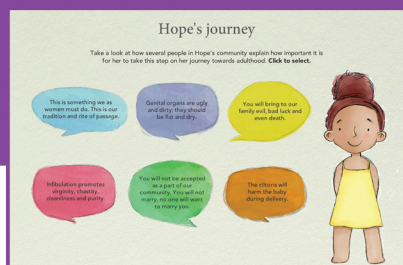


Female Genital Mutilation: Recognising and Preventing FGM
