Background Information

The Local Authority has a duty to safeguard and promote the welfare of privately fostered children under **the Children's Act 2004**. Private foster care is when a child is cared for by an adult who is not a close relative, for more than 28 days. This arrangement can occur as a result of:

- A child being sent to this country for education or health care by their birth parents from overseas
- A teenager living with the family of a boyfriend or girlfriend
- **A parent's hours of work or study makes it difficult for them to use ordinary care to look after their child**

- Recognise a private fostering situation
- **Understand the Local Authority's duties towards privately fostered children**
- Know how to notify about a private fostering arrangement
