## Aim

To introduce participants to the interface between disability and safeguarding. To recognise ways in which disabled children can be more vulnerable to harm.

## **Background Information**

Jo Norman Following completion of her MA research, Jo has been developing child protection and family welfare training through the writing of training and development material, delivery and consultancy and advising Health Trusts, voluntary, charitable and Social Welfare organisations on their responsibilities to create protective environments for children using their services. Jo has been involved in the training and development of social welfare workers including post qualified social workers for 12 years in all settings and maintains her knowledge through social research and in the writing and analysis of serious case reviews. Jo worked within the health services for several years as a nurse within the acute setting and as District Nurse and Health Visitor within the community.

- 5. Have increased knowledge and confidence in seeking support in your role and an awareness of where to get that support.
- 6. Understand the issues faced by parents of disabled children and be confident to improve partnership with parents.
