

Safeguarding Level 1 – Standard

Suitable for all staff who work with children and families

This course will enable participants to develop an up to date knowledge, awareness and understanding of Safeguarding and the processes involved. It includes:

- The definitions of physical abuse, emotional abuse, sexual abuse and neglect
- Keeping Children Safe in Education
- How to respond to concerns that a child is at risk of harm
- What information to record and what to do if you have concern

Safeguarding Level 2 – Advanced

Suitable for Designated Leads and Senior Leadership

This course will enable participants to build on their existing skills and knowledge around:

Safeguarding issues faced by children and young people. Understanding the possible impact of parenting difficulties, such as domestic abuse, mental health, substance misuse, learning difficulties on parenting capacity

Local thresholds, section 47 enquiries, Child Protection Conferences and Core Groups; working together, documentation and sharing of information regarding concerns and Serious Case Reviews. Awareness of superficial (disguised) compliance

Safeguarding Level 3 – Extended

Head Teachers and Senior Staff

This session covers: Using professional judgements to make decisions as to whether a child is suffering, or is likely to suffer, significant harm, using threshold documents; legal frameworks, Redbridge themes and trends. Monitoring and developing safeguarding practice your school, advising others, working with complexity; barriers to reporting; taking emergency action.

Briefings for all school staff

Briefings include, identification: CSE, FGM, Radicalisation, Substance Misuse, Parental Mental Health, Domestic Abuse, Harmful Sexual Behaviour, Gangs, Adverse Childhood Experiences

Supervision can also be provided for Designated Safeguarding Leads, SENCOs and Head Teachers or any other staff who could benefit from it.
