

Radicalisation Awareness Workshop

Background

This half day interactive workshop aims raise awareness among frontline staff of radicalisation and the risks associated with the targeting of vulnerable individuals by extremists – both Al Qaida/ISIL inspired and the far right. It is a learning tool for frontline staff to enhance their implementation of safeguarding statutory duties.

The session covers local and national context and threats, the process of radicalisation, and factors which may contribute to an individual's susceptibility to radicalisation. Topical examples will be used as illustrations and case studies to understand the referral process.

Learning Outcomes

At the end of the workshop, participants will have:

- An awareness and understanding of the statutory duty to prevent radicalisation and their role within it
- Increased confidence to discuss issues and concerns and how to respond to them
- The ability to use existing expertise and professional judgement to recognise potentially vulnerable individuals
