

Safeguarding Young Carers

Background:

Current estimations on the number of young carers run to 800,000. Regardless of the caring role they take on they will face additional challenges at home and at school.

With the correct support in place, the negative impacts of a caring role on the young person can be reduced. Without support caring can often be difficult, leaving a young person prone to multiple vulnerabilities which can have a negative impact on their development and safety.

This course aims to help participants:

- Understand who 'Young Carers' are and what they do.
- Recognise signs that might indicate someone is a young carer, and what their needs might be.
- Learn about their rights in law and considers what support can be put in place in Redbridge
