Background

- Have developed an understanding of how predators use technology
- Understand when and how to share information, paying attention to the legislative requirements, including developing an understanding of the <u>Data Protection Act 2018</u>, <u>Human Rights</u> <u>Act 1998</u>, provisions of the Online Safety Bill and common law duty
