Background

Neglect is the persistent failure to meet a child's basic physical and/or psychological needs, likely to result in the serious impairment of the child's health or development.

Neglect can, however, be difficult to identify and quantify. This briefing aims to support multi-agency practitioners in identifying indicators and pathways of intervention
