

Safeguarding Children Not in Education (CNIS)

Background

The briefing will provide practitioners with an overview of local safeguarding arrangements, referral pathways, escalation processes, and statutory responsibilities relating to children missing education. It will encourage reflective practice and consideration of how learning can be embedded to improve outcomes for children and families.

Learning Objectives

By the end of this briefing, participants will be able to:

- Understand the safeguarding risks associated with children missing from education,
- Recognise the statutory duties and responsibilities of partner agencies in identifying, reporting, and tracking children who are missing from education.
- Reflect on the key findings and learning from a local rapid review, considering how these relate to current practice and multi-agency working.
- Apply local procedures and pathways effectively, ensuring timely referrals, information sharing, and appropriate escalation where concerns persist.
- Identify barriers to engagement and attendance and understand the importance of professional curiosity in exploring the lived experiences of children and families.
