Background

The online world opens up immense opportunities for children and young people. It is integral to modern day youth culture. It also, however, carries many threats. This course aims to equip staff with an understanding of what the risks are and how to prevent, recognise and respond to them.

Learning Outcomes

- Understand how to minimize the risk to children using technology
- Have an understanding of modern-day use of technology and the context in which children and young people use it
- Have developed an awareness of the risks involved
- Have developed an awareness and understanding of the legislative context for safeguarding children in a digital world
- Know elements of good practice to keep children safe when using technology
- Have developed an understanding of how predators use technology
- Understand when and how to share information, paying attention to the legislative requirements, including developing an understanding of key legislation, such as the [Online Safety Act 2023](#)
