Background

The course is of particular relevance to practitioners who work with, or come into contact with, children and families and/or vulnerable adults who are parents or carers of children and who might be involved in referral or contribute to safeguarding assessments.

- Developed knowledge and understanding about forms of maltreatment and indicators of significant harm
- Developed confidence in identifying and responding to children at risk
- An understanding of how to apply the principles that underpin effective child protection practice
